St John Festive Days: *It is a celebration not a memorial service.*

- ❖ Apron of choice is appropriate
- ❖ D.D.G.M's, Grand Officers, W.M's, and Wardens may wear their collars.
- ❖ Black badges with or without emblem
- ❖ Black or dark suits
- ❖ Black socks and shoes
- ❖ Black ties (bow or long tie)
- ❖ Pocket squares may be worn
- ❖ It is a Blue Lodge Function all others are to dress as such.
- ❖ No nose or earrings.

Prince Hall Festive Day: *It is a celebration in honor of our founder. As such we dress displaying all of our masonic colors.*

- ❖ The three principal officers of each house are to be dressed in their specific Regalia, along with badges, and pins.
- ❖ All others are to be dressed in traditional masonic dress with the collars of the office in which they hold.
- ❖ Blue or white aprons may be worn. White gloves with or without emblem
- ❖ Those who are designated Emeritus are to wear their white badges.
- ❖ Honorary Past Grand Masters are to be dressed as appointed grand lodge officers.
